I hope you have all had a lovely summer and that your children are excited for a new school year ahead. They have already made a great start to Year 6. In this letter, you will find out some helpful information about class routines and the curriculum in Year 6.

Staff

Year 6 are taught by Miss Anthony, supported by Mrs Mallinson (HLTA).

Homework

Spelling Homework

A list of spellings will be handed out each Monday morning. These need to be practised for a test the following Monday.

Maths and English Homework

Handed out on a Wednesday and due back the following Monday. Homework will sometimes take the form of a worksheet/task in your child's homework book; other times it may be an online task through Mathletics and Literacy Planet.

Reading Homework

Reading Records will be checked each Tuesday and the children will have the opportunity to select a new book from our reading scheme. We encourage each child to read aloud at home at least three times each week. Please sign your child's reading record and leave a comment after they have read aloud to an adult. Raffle tickets will be rewarded each week to children with three signatures. These raffle tickets will go into a mini prize draw at the end of each half term. Please ensure that your child has their school reading book in school each day so that staff can listen to readers throughout the week.

Water Bottles

Pupils can bring their own water bottle to school each day. Please ensure that this is filled up each morning before coming to school and that your child's name is printed clearly on the bottle.

Pencil Cases

All pupils have been provided with their own individual school pencil case, containing all necessary stationery. Therefore, no additional stationery needs to come into school.

Reading Folders

Reading folders must be brought into school each day and are stored at the back of the classroom. Please do not send in any large bags as they pose a health and safety risk in the corridors.

PE

PE will be taught on Mondays and Fridays. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit. Pupils will need a warm/waterproof jacket on PE days as cold and wet weather does not prevent us from going outside.

SATs

The Key Stage 2 SATs are currently timetabled from Monday 9th May - Thursday 12th May 2022. More information will follow in the spring term.
